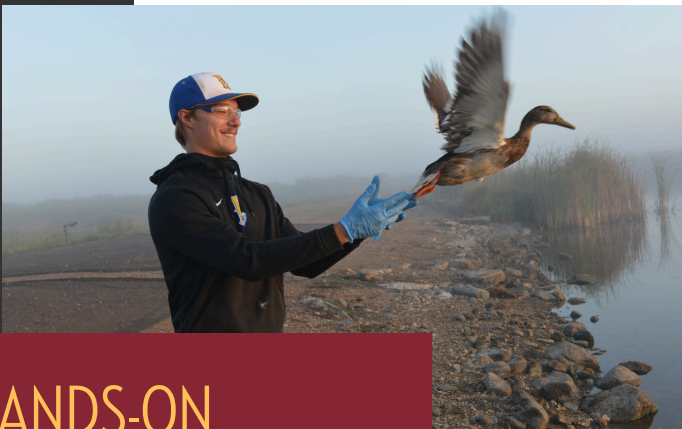


## AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL RESOURCES

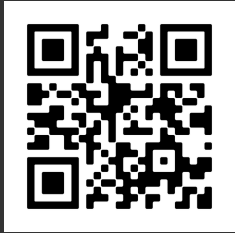
### READY.
