










Average quality of interactions for first years and seniors Mean rating on a 7-point scale from 1="Poor" to 7="Excellent"







UMC contributions to a students knowledge, skills, and personal development in thinking critically and analytically (% responding "Very much" or "Quite a bit")








Average hours spent working on or off campus



About how many courses which students have taken or currently enrolled include a community-based project (% responding "All" or "Most")




Students who have or currently working with a faculty member on a research project (% responding "Done or In-progress")


