The following policy is effective starting Spring Semester 2009

UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA, CROOKSTON SEMESTER SCHEDULE TIME PATTERNS AND RULES

NO CLASSES WILL BE SCHEDULED ON THURSDAYS BETWEEN 12:00 AND 2:00 P.M.

LECTURE CLASSES

- All daytime lecture classes will begin on the hour, with the exception of Four-Credit Class Option B (7:40 a.m.).
- Evening classes may begin at 5:00 p.m. or later and are not restricted by days of the week or time blocks.
- Exceptions to these rules may be proposed to the Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs for approval.

One-Credit Class Options

- A. Meet for 50 minutes any one day per week, beginning on the hour, at any hour (except between 12:00 and 2:00 p.m. on Th).
- B. Note: One-credit classes meeting twice a week follow the rules for two-credit classes. One-credit classes meeting three times a week follow the rules for three-credit classes.

Two-Credit Class Options

- A. Meet for 50 minutes on M and W, or W and F, or M and F, beginning on the hour, at any hour.
- B. Meet for 50 minutes T and Th, beginning on the hour, at any hour (except between 12:00 and 2:00 p.m. on Th).
- C. Meet for 100 minutes on T or Th, beginning at 8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m. (12:00 p.m. on T okay), 2:00 p.m., or 4:00 p.m.

Three-Credit Class Options

- A. Meet for 50 minutes on M, W, F beginning on the hour at any hour.
- B. Meet for 75 minutes on T and Th, beginning at 8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m., or 4:00 p.m.

Four-Credit Class Options

- A. Meet for 50 minutes on M, F, and two other days, beginning on the hour, at any hour (except between 12:00 and 2:00 p.m. on Th).
- B. Meet for 70 minutes on M, W, F, 7:40 a.m. to 8:50 a.m., or beginning at 3:00 p.m. or later.
- C. Meet for 100 minutes on T and Th, beginning at 8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m., or 4:00 p.m.

Five-Credit Class Options

A. Meet for 50 minutes M, T, W, Th, F beginning on the hour, at any hour (except Th between 12:00 and 2:00 p.m.)

LABORATORY CLASSES

- Laboratory classes will be scheduled in consultation with Department Heads and the Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs.
- Laboratory classes will follow start times as outlined above for M, W, F or T and Th.
