² Institutions with reaffirmation visits in 2015-2016 that completed a Systems Portfolio in 2012-13 and received a Systems Appraisal after July 1, 2013 or that completed a Systems Portfolio in 2013-14 will have this requirement waived. An institution may elect to revise and update their Systems Portfolio during 2014-15, as the review of Commission Criteria and Core Components will be conducted using the latest institutional portfolio on file. Should an earlier version of the portfolio not adequately address the Criteria and Core Components as required, an update for the CQR team would be in the institution's best interest.
